The Adult Day Services program supports individuals 21 and older who need support and instruction to maintain or develop new skills for independence and community inclusion.

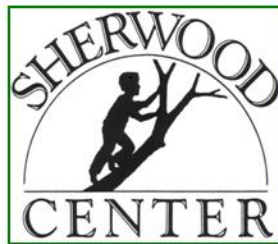
Family Support Program

When founded in 1974, Sherwood Center became the first agency that provided specialized education and support services to individuals with autism.

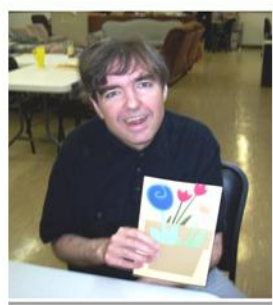
Today, Sherwood Center provides high-quality services to people with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and a wide range of developmental disabilities.

TEACHING TOOLS



- **Functional Life Skills** – Involves meal planning, preparation, personal and home care, shopping, calculation and general skills for independence.
- **Positive Behavior Support** – Development of interactive environments that enable us to best support individuals in our care.
- **Communication Training** – Instruction with diverse communication methods personalized for each individual. Instruction for verbal language, basic sign language and picture communication is available.



TEACHING TOOLS

- **Program Assessment** – Data is derived through observation and examined to determine program effectiveness. This provides the foundation for instruction and ensures all individuals will make progress.
- **Community Inclusion** – Involves frequent contact and participation in a wide variety of settings with a strong emphasis on developing beneficial social skills.



- **Volunteer Opportunities** – Provide networking with other organizations to give back to the community and to increase work-related skills.
- **Transition Services** – We help individuals and families prepare for life changes such as employment or volunteer opportunities.
- **Physical and Recreational Activities** – Individuals participate in physical exercise and leisure activities both on site and in the larger community.
